

Do Not Start Before Contacting the ARC

Listed below are actions that require the approval of the Architectural Committee before beginning your project.

(The park has adopted a five-foot rule which requires any structure or addition on your property to be at least five feet from the property line on the sides and ten feet from the road. This rule was enacted to ensure no water run off impacts your neighbor's property. A water management engineer's written approval is required if the five-foot rule is overridden. Property Owners are responsible for the expense that may be required by the Engineer for proper drainage.)
